Summary: Operates, inspects and maintains aquatic animal life support systems for fish, marine mammals, reptiles, and birds. Responsible for 5 million gallons of salt water. Reports to the Life Support Manager.

Job Duties:

- Operate, inspect, and maintain life support systems in all park areas. Walk on multiple daily rounds and check all valves, pumps, chillers, pressure gauges, heaters and bio-filters for proper operation.
- Conducts chemical analysis of water systems. Interprets readings and makes adjustments as needed
- Checks the health and appearance of all animals in assigned areas and report any problems to appropriate personnel immediately.
- Assists in other animal care areas as assigned.
- Maintains accurate logs and records.
- Uses computers to monitor and control filtration systems.
- Checks water levels and appearance of all pools and tanks.
- SCUBA dives pools for inspections, maintenance, and animal related procedures.
- Other duties as assigned.
- Adheres to all departmental and company policies as well as state and federal regulations.

Minimum Qualifications:

- 1-3 years of experience with life support systems.
- Open water SCUBA diver certification preferred but not necessary.
- General mechanical aptitude and strong math skills required.
- Must be able to read and write in English.
- Must be able to interpret values on numerical gauges.
- Must be in excellent physical condition and be able to lift and carry up to 60 lbs. Must be able to swim, walk, stand, climb stairs and ladders, and duck under and climb over filtration piping.
- Must be able to work both indoors and outdoors in variable types of weather and temperatures.
- Must be willing to work with chemicals including acids, chlorine, and ozone.
- Must be available to work days, afternoons, nights, holidays and weekends. (shift work)
- Prior computer experience helpful.
- High School diploma or the equivalent.
