### Position Purpose:

- To maintain all the wooden structures throughout the park to insure a complete safety conscience environment.

---

### Scope of Responsibilities:

- Installs, repair and maintenance on wooden roller coaster, includes daily inspections.
- Installs cat walks, fencing, woodwork, and associated hardware for park rides.
- Remodels offices, buildings, and facilities. Makes and installs cabinetwork, installs carpeting and flooring, builds shelving, hangs doors, hangs pictures and bulletin boards, installs locks and hardware.
- Works from plans or general descriptions designs and builds special purpose furniture, cabinets, etc.
- Cuts and installs glass, counter tops, queue lines, etc.
- Installs and repairs ceramic tile.
- Makes general repairs to buildings; winterizes; patches holes.
- Builds and installs signs. Pours concrete.
- Repairs roofs and guttering.
- Hangs and repairs drop ceilings.
- Welds metal for repair and minor construction.
- Generally undertakes all repairs that do not involve electrical, HVAC, or plumbing.
- Operates a broad variety of tools and equipment to include motor vehicles.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

- Must be at least 18 years old.

Factors	Substantiating Data
Education	Requires a thorough knowledge of carpentry and related construction skills. At least one other skill such as upholstery, masonry, tile, required. Equivalent to high school graduate plus additional training or apprenticeship.
Experience	3 to 5 years
Complexity Of Duties	Must be able to perform satisfactory in a wide variety of skill areas. On night or weekend shifts, prioritize work. Must meet deadlines to insure park operation.
Supervision	Under general supervision. Work alone following pre-determined objectives.
Errors/Safety	Careless, negligent or improper performance may cause damage of up to 200\$ to equipment or process. Careless, negligent, or improper performance may cause loss of up to 1000\$. Inattention to carelessness could cause lost time and/or injury.
Contact With Others	Regular contacts with all maintenance divisions, vendors, contractors, and other departments.
Confidential Data	None.
Visual and Mental Demand	Frequent mental and visual attention. Requires constant alertness and activity.
Physical Demand	Requires continuous standing, walking, bending, eye/hand coordination, near vision, hearing, speech, and stepping up/down. Requires frequent kneeling, manual dexterity, gross motor skills, and color definition. Frequently requires sitting, crawling, working in difficult positions, pushing, pulling, or BI-manual dexterity. Frequently carries and lifts 1-100 pounds.
Working Conditions	Continuously works outside and closely with others. Frequently works in excessive heat/cold, is exposed to noise/vibrations, and chemical/solvents/cleaner/detergents. Occasionally works alone, is exposed to dirt/dust, and water. Sometimes is exposed to excessive humidity/dampness and occasionally walks on uneven surfaces. Rarely works inside. Exposed to all weather elements. Frequently operates motor vehicles.
