



## 2012 Information & Guidelines

### Information

- Six Flags welcomes all vocal & instrumental performance ensembles from elementary schools, middle schools, high schools & churches.
- Your performance location will be determined by the type and size of your group.
- Dressing rooms are not available.
- Six Flags is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. All equipment must be returned to your vehicle or rental locker inside the park.
- Friends and family are welcome to join the fun. Make sure they order discounted tickets.
- Extra tickets may be purchased on your performance day for the up-charged price. Please bring a copy of the shipment voucher from your original order to the Guest Relations building or visit [sixflags.com/greatadventure](http://sixflags.com/greatadventure) and enter the promo code: MUSIC in the upper right hand corner of the screen.

### Guidelines

- **Six Flags is a family destination. Please make sure your group's costumes, music and performance is appropriate for Guests of all ages. If you have any questions, please ask in advance of your performance day.**
- You will follow signs and enter the park through the main entrance. After the gas station there will be a GUEST DROP OFF lot. Enter the Guest Drop Off. **DO NOT GET OFF THE BUS** as this is NOT your final destination. Please tell the Security Officer that you are a performance group. He will contact the Performance Rep and give you further instructions.
- Equipment vehicles will be brought to the closest location possible to unload, however, you will still be expected to carry all equipment a substantial distance.
- **A Medical and Publicity Release form must be submitted for each participant on your performance day. Anyone without a Medical and Publicity Release form will not be permitted to perform.**
- Please estimate at least 1 hour from time of arrival on property to get through security and get to your performance space in addition to any dressing or warm ups necessary.
- It is important to begin your performance on time to keep from overlapping with other performances in the park.
- **No costume changes or shoe changes permitted during your performance time. Six Flags recommends keeping costumes to a minimum (i.e. t-shirts or robes).**
- Six Flags is not equipped to handle acrobatic or gymnastic routines. Please refrain from incorporating them into your performance.
- **Props are DISCOURAGED.** All props must be cleared through our Security Department prior to your performance day.
