Information

Showcase Theater is an indoor venue. Dimensions are available upon request but can change with the addition or removal of set pieces. The floor is covered in black rubber tiles.

Theater doors open 15 min after park opening (check operating calendar for exact times).

Dressing rooms are not available. There are bathroom facilities next to Showcase Theater.

Six Flags is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Rental lockers are available inside the park and outside the main entrance.

Friends and family are welcome to join the fun. Make sure they order discounted tickets.

Extra tickets may be purchased on your performance day for the up-charged price. Please bring a copy of the shipment voucher from your original order to the Guest Relations building.

Guidelines

Six Flags is a family destination. Please make sure your group's music, choreography and costumes are appropriate for Guests of all ages. If you have any questions, please ask in advance of your performance day.

For Check-In, please have your participants come to Showcase Theater with their own medical release forms. (Medical Release forms can be checked-in individually or as a group).

A Medical Release/Liability form must be submitted for each participant on your performance day. Anyone without a Medical Release form will not be permitted backstage.

Please have your dancers dressed and **ready to perform 1 hour prior** to their scheduled performance time. Please inform all family and friends to arrive at this time as to not miss your performance.

Dancers will be brought backstage as a troupe just prior to performance time.

Each troupe is limited to 15 minutes of performance time. At our discretion, music and lights may be dimmed if time is exceeded.

No costume changes or shoe changes permitted during your performance time. Six Flags recommends keeping costumes to a minimum (i.e. studio shirts & leotards).

No duets, solos or trios.

Six Flags is not equipped to handle acrobatic or gymnastic routines. Please refrain from incorporating them into your performance.

Props are DISCOURAGED. All props must be cleared through our Security Department prior to your performance day.

Bring your music on a CD or MP3 player. Please bring backup. ***Provide 1 person who is familiar with the routines to sit in the sound booth with the sound technician to insure the performers are ready and that the music is being played, paused and stopped in the correct order.***

Bring an introduction neatly written or typed on a separate piece of paper.
