SIX FLAGS GREAT ADVENTURE PARK POLICIES

GROUP Leaders must

.....be at least 18 years of age

.....possess valid identification

.....remain in the park as long as the group is on property

.....accept responsibility for the group

General Policies

Safety is our number one priority. Together, our safety partnership will ensure nothing inappropriate enters the Park and your visit will be safe, educational and fun. Please remind students and chaperones that all bags will be checked upon entrance to the Park.

- ★ **Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times in the theme Park.**
- ★ **Profane language, running, line breaking or disorderly conduct may result in ejection from the Park with no refund.**
- ★ **Coolers, radios, tape players, weapons of any kind, clothing with obscene or offensive words or depictions can not be brought into the Park.**
- ★ **Illegal drugs are prohibited. Alcohol may not be brought into the Park.**
- ★ **All bags, knapsacks, and purses are subject to inspection prior to entering the Park.**
- ★ **Food, cans and bottles are not permitted through the Main Gate.**
- ★ **Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. Smoking is not permitted in ride queue lines, restrooms, indoor facilities or indoor theatres.**

If, at any time during your visit, you encounter wrongful behavior, please contact one of our host or hostess team members or our Security Division. We will assist you in any way possible.

One other suggestion...it is always a good idea to select a "meeting site" before you enter the Park so that everyone in your group can get back together at the end of the day. We cannot page for separated individuals or groups. The Fountain at the entrance to the park is a convenient meeting space.
