

PICNIC POLICIES

Q: What is the minimum number of people required to reserve the Picnic Grove?

A: The minimum number of people is 100 for both admission and meal tickets. Ask your Account Executive about options for groups under 100.

Q: Is there a deposit required to reserve our picnic date?

A: A minimum \$1,000 non-refundable deposit is required for groups of 100+ and \$1500 for groups under 100. Deposits are due within ten (10) days of signing the Picnic Agreement and will be credited towards your account.

Q: How long will the food be served?

A: Your food will be served for the first 1 ½ hours of your grove time.

Q: Can my group stay in the Picnic Grove for longer than two hours?

A: Yes. There is now an option to reserve the Picnic Grove from 3:00PM-7:00PM with food being served for the first 3 hours. Ask your Account Executive about this special option.

Q: Is there a State of Illinois Sales Tax?

A: Yes, the current Sales Tax does apply on food cost only. Any group requesting tax exemptions must submit a copy of their Illinois tax exemption certificate upon signing the Picnic Agreement. Picnic packages for groups under 100 include sales tax.

Q: Is there a minimum subsidy required?

A: Yes. To ensure the success of your picnic, we require that you subsidize the event so that the per person cost is no higher than \$20.00.

Q: When must I select a menu for my group?

A: We ask that you select a menu upon signing the Picnic Agreement. If you are unable to choose a menu upon signing the Agreement, Six Flags must receive your menu selection by fax or mail 45 days prior to your picnic date. Picnic packages for groups under 100 include the standard meal listed previously.

Q: Who needs a meal ticket?

A: Anyone entering the Picnic Grove must present a full meal ticket. Children two (2) and under eat FREE and do not require a meal ticket.

Q: Are guests allowed to re-enter the Picnic Grove once they leave?

A: Guests are not allowed to re-enter the Picnic Grove once they leave.

Q: How does the guaranteed meal count work?

A: You will need to give a final meal guarantee to Six Flags by 12:00 noon three (3) business days prior to your picnic. Your organization will be billed for the number of people served or the final food guarantee, whichever is greater.

Q: Can my organization bring in items/merchandise to be distributed in the Picnic Grove?

A: Six Flags does not permit organizations to bring in items for distribution. Six Flags has a list of discounted items available for purchase ranging from shirts to stuffed animals and other novelty items.

Q: Are food and beverages allowed to be taken out of the Picnic Grove?

A: All food and beverages served in the Picnic Grove must be consumed in the Picnic Grove.

Q: When is the final payment required for our company picnic?

A: You have up to ten (10) days following your event to return any unused tickets to your Account Executive or Six Flags via the Federal Express prepaid envelope included in your initial ticket order. Final payment is due 30 days following your picnic date.

Q: Are personal checks acceptable for payment?

A: No. Only Company checks, credit cards or money orders are accepted for payment. Also, no two party checks are accepted.

Q: Is smoking allowed in the Picnic Grove?

A: Smoking is allowed in designated areas on blue benches only. Violators will be escorted from the park without a refund.
