

Best Ways to Enjoy the Park
Six Flags Magic Mountain- 2007

- Plan your day before you arrive by downloading a park map so that you can map out your course of action or once you've arrived at the park, grab a park map (the map is provided at the parking Toll Plaza, but an additional one can be obtained at Guest Relations) and plot your course.

The park is basically one big circle.

- If you have small children then head to Bugs Bunny World to the right
- or if you're a coaster rider, head left up Baja Ridge to X, Viper and Revolution

- Wear comfortable shoes
- The best time to visit the park is Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday
- In the morning, most guests go to attractions near the gate, or the newest one. Head to the back of the park first and ride the rides while the lines are short
- As a rule, the wait for coasters is longer in the morning and water rides are more crowded in the afternoon
- If you have come to ride TATSU, come early. As the day goes by the lines get longer. It's the hot new ride and the lines will remain constant day or night
- Ride rides during the traditional meal times usually between 12:00 and 2:00 PM and 5:00 and 7:00 PM, this is when most guests stop to eat
- Plan your meals before or after the above times. For a relaxing sit down, air conditioned meal try Mooseburger Lodge and Laughing Dragon restaurants where they take reservations
- Take a leisurely approach to the park, visit all nine themed lands and then go back to your favorite spots
- Best value for unlimited fun is a Play Pass or Season Pass!
- Try a park Combo Ticket for both parks!
For some summer fun...you can splash in the waterpark by day and theme park at night for the Looney Tunes Nites Parade and fireworks
