INFORMATION PACKET

Thank you for sharing your talents with Six Flags Magic Mountain. We ask that our Guest Star performance groups follow the rules listed below in order to ensure a seamless performance and an enjoyable park visit.

- ★ All guests must have a ticket to enter the park.
- ★ All guests must enter through the Front Gate. Any and all equipment must be carried through the Front Gate and to the performance area without assistance from park personnel.
- ★ Prior to arriving at the park, it may be necessary to consider modifying your normal performance routine in order to ensure that all equipment and instruments you intend to bring can easily be brought through the Front Gate.
- ★ Please have your entire group come to the performance area 20 minutes prior to your scheduled performance time (30 minutes prior to your scheduled performance time for Marching Bands).
- ★ Your Six Flags performance contact will be waiting for you at the performance area.
- ★ Six Flags will not store any equipment or instruments after your performance. Please make arrangements to place these items back on your bus while you enjoy the park.

*No dressing rooms will be available.



Six Flags Magic Mountain has put together the perfect way for your group to share its talents with visitors in the park.

The best part is that your group gets to enjoy the day, too! For 50% off our full-price main gate, one-day ticket, your performers, family and friends will get a full day at Six Flags Magic Mountain plus the opportunity to perform. You can also purchase meal vouchers and vehicle parking in advance. A minimum of 15 tickets must be purchased. **One (1) chaperone ticket will be issued for every 15 tickets purchased.**

Performance Details

Six Flags Magic Mountain allows many types of groups to perform: marching and concert bands, choral ensembles, dance troupes and more! If you're not sure if we can accommodate your group type, simply call to find out! All performances are held on the Golden Bear Sierra Stage or an uncovered, 90 x 120 foot concrete area. Six Flags will supply (2) microphones, speakers, a CD player and a technician for all performances. Any additional equipment or logistical requests may not be available. Advance requests are required. *Marching bands have the option of marching through the park on a pre-selected 20 minute route.

Putting this program together is as easy as 1, 2, 3...

- 1** Select the date of your performance. Performances are available at 11AM daily (during normal operations). You must call Six Flags Special Events at (661) 255-4501 to check availability and reserve a date and time. (Please visit www.sixflags.com/magicmountain to check the operating calendar)
- 2** After reserving a date and time with the Account Executive, please submit the order form and payment at least 10 days before your visit date. Please note: These tickets are nonrefundable. In the event of inclement weather at performance time, the performance will be cancelled and you can enjoy the rest of your day in the park!
- 3** Please enclose a check, money order or credit card payment for the total amount. Make checks payable to SIX FLAGS (no personal checks accepted). The nonrefundable payment and ticket order must be received at least 10 days prior to your performance date.
